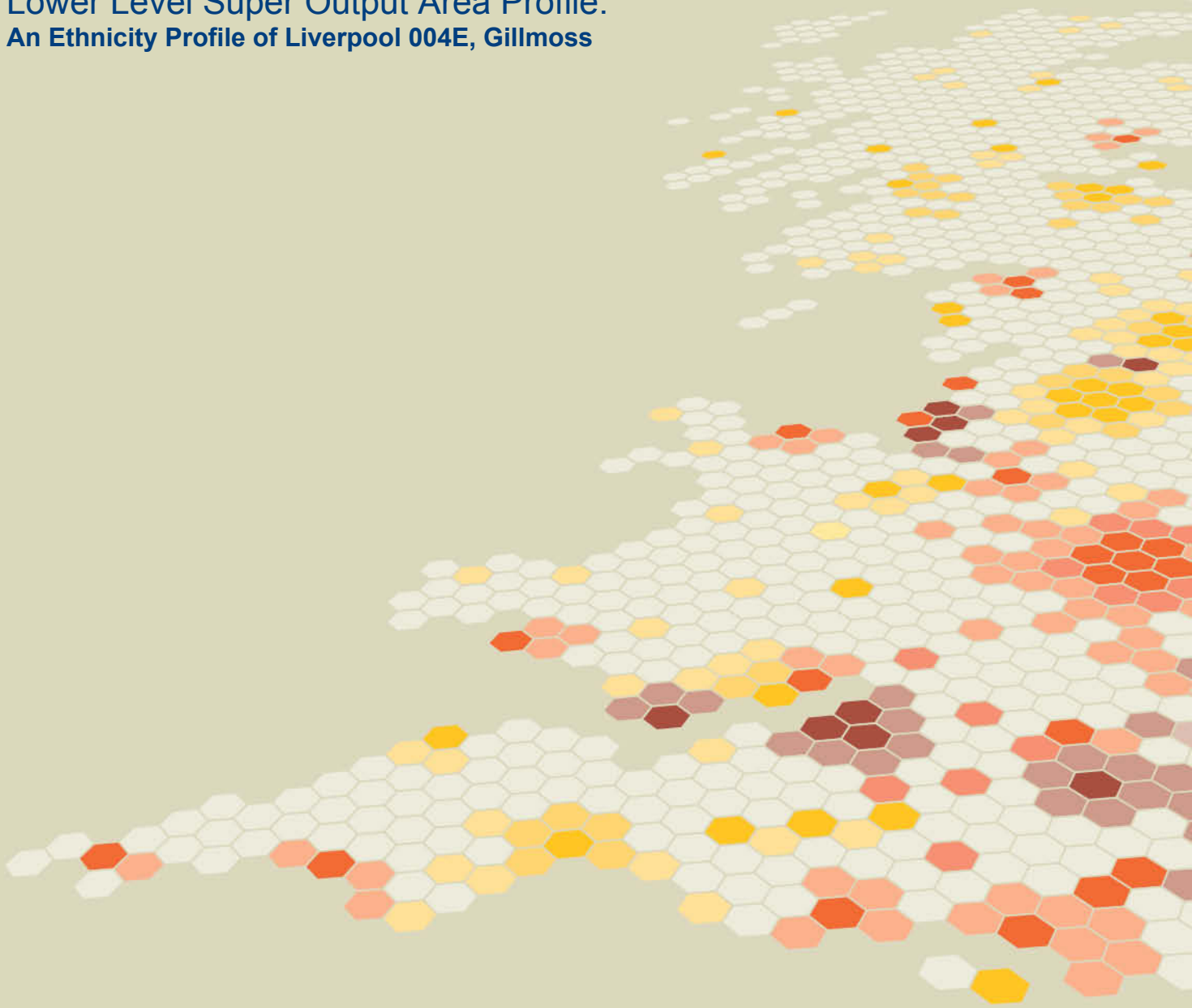

Ethnicity Profile: Liverpool 004E

Introduction

Demographic characteristics have a fundamental influence on the social and economic development of an area. Understanding the extent of ethnic diversity is important both for being able to target policies at different communities and for the impact on community cohesion and involvement. This ethnicity profile assesses Liverpool 004E according to the proportions of different ethnic groups.

Liverpool 004E is ranked 10546 out of 32482 lower level super output areas on the proportion of its population classified as Non-White, placing the area in the highest 40% of lower level super output areas nationally.

With 5.63% of residents classified as Non-White, Liverpool 004E is above the national median. This is shown in the map, where areas with darker shadings have higher levels of Non-White residents and those with lighter shadings have lower levels.

By comparison, the proportion of Non-White residents in Gillmoss was 3.84%, the Liverpool figure was 5.68%, the Greater Merseyside figure was 2.74% and the national figure was 9.08%.

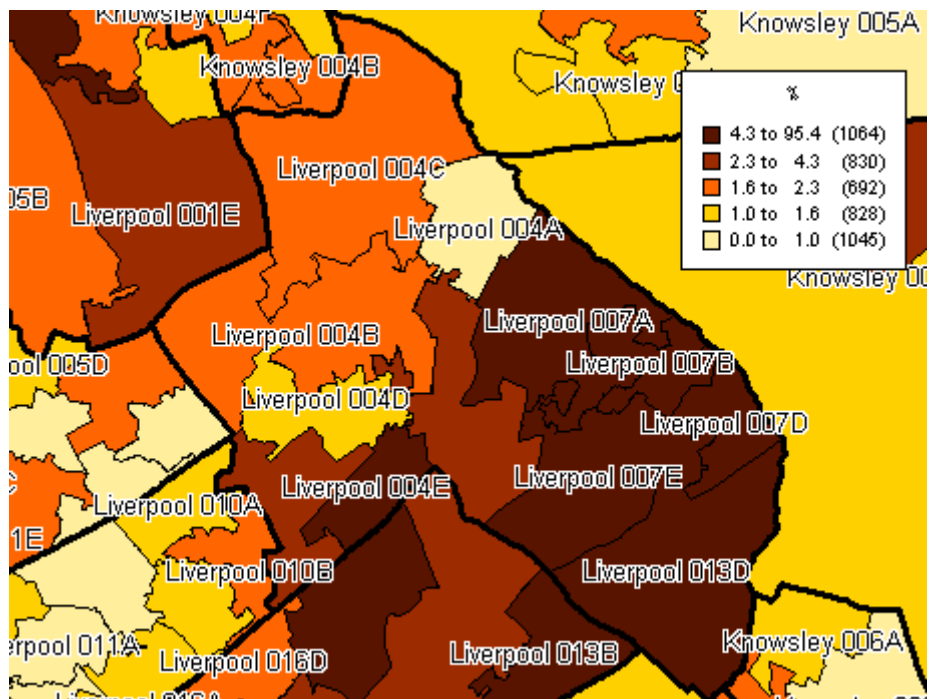

Proportion Of Population Classified As Non-White

The map shows the proportion of the population classified as Non-White in lower level super output areas within Gillmoss. The areas with very dark shading have higher levels of Non-White residents and those with lighter shadings have lower levels.

With 5.63% of it's residents classified as Non-White, Liverpool 004E is in the highest 40% of lower level super output areas and is in a ward that is in the highest 40% of wards nationally on the proportion of the population that is Non-White.

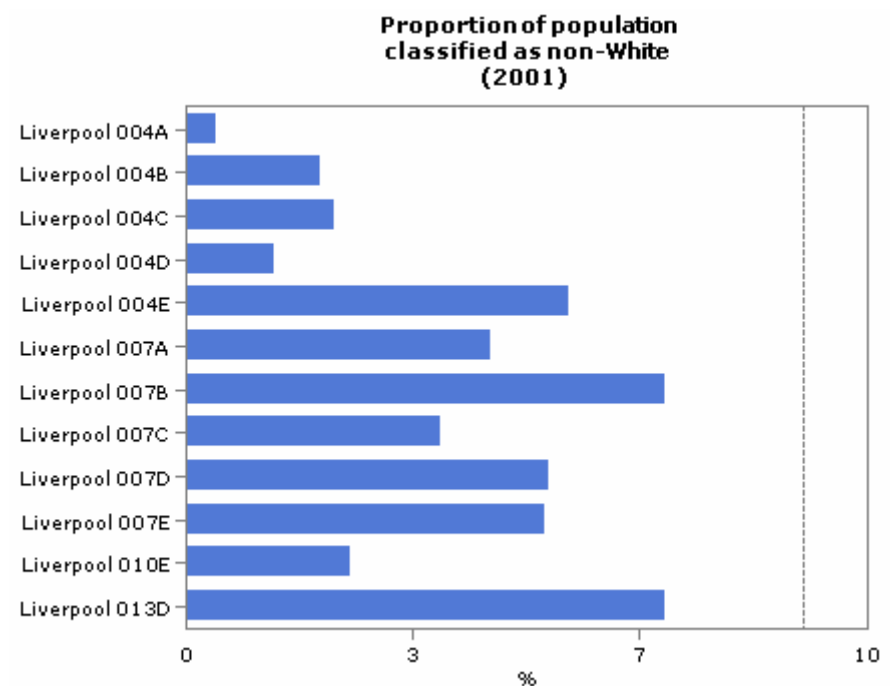

Proportion Of Population Classified As Non-White

The bar chart shows the proportion of Non-White residents for lower level super output areas in Gillmoss.

The chart shows that at 5.63%, Liverpool 004E has an above average proportion of Non-White residents. By comparison, the Great Britain average, shown by the dashed line, is 9.08%.

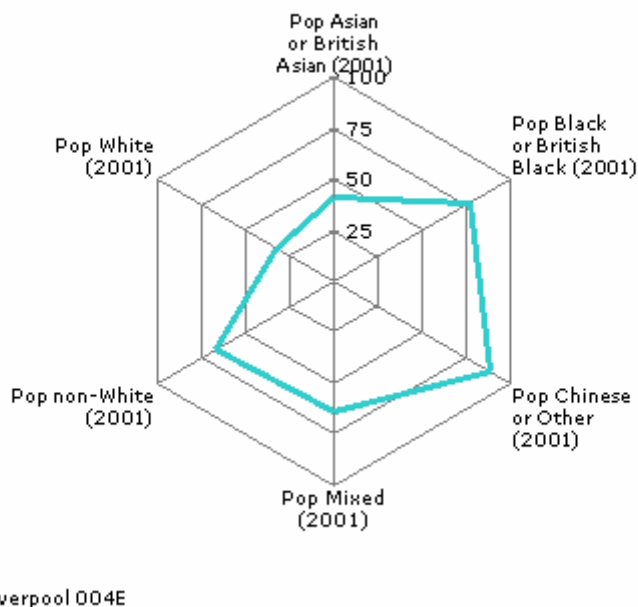

Ethnicity Indicators

The spider chart is a way of showing how Liverpool 004E rates against the national median. Data for every lower level super output area in Great Britain is converted into a percentile score, with the highest ranking area scoring 100 and the bottom area zero. The national median is shown by the 50th percentile.

The chart shows that Liverpool 004E has a level of ethnic diversity above the national median. The chart also shows a range of ethnicity indicators for Liverpool 004E.

Ethnicity Indicators Summary

Looking at some of the indicators from the table we find that:

- The proportion of the population classified as White was 94.37%, which is low by national standards, with Liverpool 004E ranking in the bottom 40% of lower level super output areas. By comparison, the Gillmoss average was 96.16% and the national figure was 90.92%.
- The proportion of the population classified as from a Mixed background was 1.22%, which is high by national standards, with Liverpool 004E ranking in the top 40% of lower level super output areas. By comparison, the Gillmoss average was 0.68% and the national figure was 1.31%.
- The proportion of the population classified as Asian or British Asian was 0.61%, which is average by national standards, with Liverpool 004E ranking in the middle 20% of lower level super output areas. By comparison, the Gillmoss average was 0.62% and the national figure was 4.58%.
- The proportion of the population classified as Black or Black British was 1.70%, which is high by national standards, with Liverpool 004E ranking in the top 40% of lower level super output areas. By comparison, the Gillmoss average was 0.36% and the national figure was 2.30%.
- The proportion of the population classified as Chinese or any other ethnic background was 2.10%, which is very high by national standards, with Liverpool 004E ranking in the top 20% of lower level super output areas. By comparison, the Gillmoss average was 2.18% and the national figure was 0.89%.

Nearest Neighbours

Proportion of population classified as Asian or British Asian	The percentage of people classified as Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi or Other Asian. Classifications are based on Census ethnic groupings.
Proportion of population classified as Black or Black British	The percentage of people classified as Caribbean, African or Other Black. Classifications are based on Census ethnic groupings.
Proportion of population classified as Chinese or Other Ethnic Group	The percentage of people classified as Chinese or Other Ethnic Group. Classifications are based on Census ethnic groupings.
Proportion of population classified as Mixed	The percentage of people classified as White and Black Caribbean, White and Black African, White and Asian or Other Mixed. Classifications are based on Census ethnic groupings.
Proportion of population classified as Non-White	The number of people classified as Non-White (Mixed Ethnic Group (White and Black Caribbean, White and Black African, White and Asian, Other Mixed), Caribbean, African, Other Black, Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi, Other Asian, Chinese or Other Ethnic Group). Classifications are based on Census ethnic groupings.
Proportion of population classified as White	The percentage of people classified as British, Irish or Other White. Classifications are based on Census ethnic groupings.

Proportion of population classified as Asian or British Asian	The number of people classified as Asian or British Asian as a proportion of the total population.
Proportion of population classified as Black or Black British	The number of people classified as Black or Black British as a proportion of the total population.
Proportion of population classified as Chinese or Other Ethnic Group	The number of people classified as Chinese or Other Ethnic Group as a proportion of the total population.
Proportion of population classified as Mixed	The number of people classified as Mixed Ethnic Group as a proportion of the total population.
Proportion of population classified as Non-White	The percentage of people classified as Non-White as a proportion of the total population.
Proportion of population classified as White	The number of people classified as White as a proportion of the total population.
